



A brief history

Tim started his apprenticeship as an organ pipe maker in 1979 at the well known firm of F J Rogers Ltd in Leeds, Yorkshire (UK). After completing his 5 year apprenticeship in 1984 he was employed at Rogers for a further 10 years. During that time he produced pipes for most of the leading organ building firms of the UK, Europe, USA and Japan. He emigrated to Australia in 1992 and commenced his own business a few years later manufacturing organ pipes.

Tim has an extensive overall knowledge of the manufacture of organ pipes and in matching alloys and adding impurities such as copper, antimony and other trace elements. All of his pipes are hand cast, planed, rolled, cut and soldered.
